### **October is the month of the Holy Rosary**

#### **How to Pray the rosary:**

Starter Prayers: Our Father, 3 x Hail Mary, Glory be to the Father.

For each story, think about what was happening.

While you are thinking, pray Our Father, 10 x Hail Mary, Glory be to the Father.

#### **The Joyful Mysteries**

**The Annunciation** - when the Angel Gabriel told Mary she would have a baby boy and he would be called Jesus.

**The Visitation** - when Mary went to see Elizabeth to tell her the news. Elizabeth shared the news that she was also going to have a baby! This son would later be known as John the Baptist.

**The Nativity** - the great story of Christmas!

**The presentation of the Lord Jesus in the temple** - as a very young baby, Mary & Joseph brought Jesus to the temple. A wise man told them that he would bring great joy and great sadness.

**The finding of Lord Jesus in the temple** - At the age of 12 Jesus went missing. He was found talking to the wise men. When Mary said she was worried, Jesus said, "Did you not know I would be in my Father's house?"

Why not pray a decade at home? The children should be able to tell you a little about what they know.
